



Financial Aid/Counseling Workshop

Attention: Financial Aid Applicants

Completion of the Financial Aid/Counseling Workshop is **MANDATORY** for Financial Aid applicants who have completed twenty four (24) units or less and/or are first time Grossmont College students *at the time of application*.

Applicants who are first time Grossmont College students and/or have completed twenty four (24) units or less by the time they apply for Financial Aid will be required to successfully complete the Financial Aid/Counseling Workshop (NO FEE). A student's Financial Aid application will not be completed until this requirement has been met.

The purpose of this workshop is to educate first time Grossmont College students about Financial Aid application procedures, provide information about all available Financial Aid programs at Grossmont College and review the Satisfactory Academic Progress requirements to be eligible for Financial Aid at Grossmont College. Students attending this workshop will also learn the basics of developing an educational plan and will be educated on academic support services available that will help them succeed as new students at Grossmont College.

There are two ways you can complete this workshop:

- 1) Take the workshop on-line. The on-line workshop is available any day or at any time. To sign up, go to our website at www.grossmont.edu/fa and select "On-line Financial Aid/Counseling Workshop" on the left side of our home page. Follow the step-by-step instructions on how to create a WebCT account and enroll on-line.
- 2) Take the workshop in person. See the dates and times below.
