



PDC 095 - "ACADEMIC/FINANCIAL AID PLANNING"

Attention: Financial Aid Applicants

Enrollment in the PDC 095 course is MANDATORY for Financial Aid applicants who have not made Satisfactory Academic Progress while receiving financial aid.

Grossmont College financial aid recipients who have not made Satisfactory Academic Progress will be required to enroll in and successfully complete PDC 095 "Academic/Financial Aid Planning" (NO FEE, 8 hour non-credit course). A student's Financial Aid application will not be completed until this course requirement has been met.

The purpose of this class is to educate disqualified Financial Aid students about Satisfactory Academic Progress requirements and financial aid application procedures as they pertain to student success at Grossmont College. Students attending the class will also develop an educational plan and learn about support services available that will help them succeed at Grossmont College. Additional success topics include note-taking, time-management, study skills, stress management, etc. To facilitate the development of an educational plan, **please bring copies of the following documents if applicable:**

1. Transcripts and transcript evaluations of courses completed at other colleges or universities (unofficial copies are acceptable for the purpose of the class).
2. Long range educational plan developed by a counselor if you already have one.
3. An articulation agreement if you plan to transfer (available in the Counseling Office).

The dates and times for this mandatory course are listed on the bottom of this form and are also listed in the *current class schedule. The following dates have been tentatively established for these courses and are subject to change and/or cancellation without notice.
