3. Submit the completed worksheet, tax forms, and any other documents your school needs to your financial aid administrator.
4. Your financial aid administrator will compare information on this worksheet and any supporting documents with the information you submitted on your application. *Your school must review the requested information, under the financial aid program rules (34 CFR, Part 668).*
